Report for Year Ending December 2015

Through careful management we were able to make substantial grants in response to this year's applications from the school. An excellent relationship continues between the Trust and the School with regular discussions taking place about grant requests, to reinforcing the school's educational strategies.

The request for education based IT, was granted. Our transparent process allows monies to be channelled throughout the year, supporting activities as they arise.

The Trust has spent money maintaining its asset, The Schoolhouse, a cottage next to the school. We continued with a programme of routine interior and exterior maintenance and this year a regular rent review, by the Valuation Office Agency.

Notwithstanding the current financial climate, the Trust's finances are in a healthy state. We anticipate being able to continue supplying the school with grants that enhance the wellbeing of both pupils and staff.

The treasurer has filed a summary of the annual accounts, which have been independently examined, and the details of the trustees, with the Charity Commission, where they can be viewed, by all, on-line under The Crudwell Free School. I have attached the full accounts for the Parish.
